Home School Agreement

The school will:

1. Encourage your child to do their best at all times.
2. Provide a broad and balanced curriculum in accordance with the requirements of the National Curriculum.
3. Encourage your child to show respect and care for others and for their surroundings.
4. Provide for the learning needs of all abilities.
5. Provide a secure, caring environment where your child will feel safe.
6. Inform you of your child's progress at regular meetings.
7. Set appropriate homework.

The family will:

1. Make sure their child arrives at school no later than 8.55am and collect their child promptly at 3.15pm.
2. Make sure their child attends regularly and contact the school on the morning of any absence.
3. Ensure their child comes to school in clean and tidy school uniform.
4. Attend consultation evenings to discuss their child's progress (twice yearly).
5. Where possible attend special assemblies, plays and concerts where their child's achievements are being celebrated.
6. Inform the school of any circumstances which may affect the work or behaviour of their child e.g. bereavement, illness, separation.
7. Not use social media in such a way as to cause grievance to the school, staff, other parents or children.
