


Snow Closures

As the wintry weather is just around the corner, this is an ideal opportunity to let you know how we will be informing parents of any unplanned closures due to bad weather. As ever, information about school closures will be available on the Hertfordshire County Council website and the local radio stations. We will also text parents using our own texting service.

This year there is also a new service provided by the county council which allows subscribers to receive up to date information via text message and email. This is in addition to our own text service and has the advantage that if HCC decide to close schools (as with the Buncefield incident) then subscribers immediately receive the notification direct from HCC. Hertfordshire County Council's School Closure Notification system

In the event of severe weather, a public emergency or unforeseen circumstances, it may be necessary for a school to close or partially close. In order to ensure parents and guardians are informed as quickly as possible of anything that may have an impact on a normal school day, this notification system has been put in place to enable messages from schools to be sent immediately via text message, email and a voice message if required.

Please take 5 minutes to register your details for any Hertfordshire school your child attends, so that you can receive immediate information and updates.

This link will direct you to the “Sign Up” page where you should click on the “sign up” button located at the top right hand side of the page on the grey strip and from there follow the instructions. It should take no more than 5 minutes to register and you can edit your information at any time should you change your mobile number or email address.

Each contact within the system can have 2 devices added for each communication type if you wish to – this means that in addition to adding your own mobile number and email address, you could include the mobile number and email address of a partner or a grandparent in your registration process. They too, would then receive any messages in relation to the school’s closure. Alternatively, interested parties could register themselves separately.

If you have children at more than one school you can register for those schools too in a single registration process by selecting all schools you have children at. Once signed up you will receive messages relating to the open or closed status of your child’s school.

Having said all of that, it is of course always our intention to stay open whatever the weather! However if insufficient staff are able to reach school or site conditions create a health and safety risk, then we would be forced to do so.

Plumbing

Last week we had our very own Lake Windermere! Somewhat smaller and decidedly less scenic, it was the result of an underground leak in our cold water system. As a result the cold water system has been turned off and the school is operating on mains water. Unfortunately this means that not all toilets are in use and the ‘fix’ is quite temporary. We are getting quotes to update the water system in its entirety, because after 60 years some of the current pipework is corroded and needs to be retired.

Clubs

The letter regarding clubs went out at the end of last week and there has, as usual, been an overwhelming response. Allocations will go out next week so that you can plan for the spring term. Mrs Shaporenkova, who runs our chess club, would welcome some additional helpers – particularly with beginner players.
