<p align="center"><u>Wider World</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Find something you would like to buy and set a budget to save so you could buy it. Record how you will earn money and how long it will take you to save. Looking at some of the natural disasters around the world, can you invent something to help the people affected? Research one country and compare it to the UK. For example, is the food, language and religion different? 	<p align="center"><u>Maths</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Look for special offer vouchers in shops, magazines or online. Look at the original price and use the voucher to calculate the discount and new price. Plan and make a meal for your family: include measurements for the ingredients and how much they will cost. Create a bar chart to show how much protein (eg meat or fish), fibre, carbohydrates, fats and sugars you have in a week. 	<p align="center"><u>PE</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Design an obstacle course. You could set it up in your garden or a local park and give it a go! Design a sports kit for your favourite team. Design a poster that explains the benefits of doing exercise every day.
<p align="center"><u>Arts</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Transform a fictional book character into a puppet or figure. Design a comic strip for a character you have read about this year. Research the work of L.S Lowry and J Constable. Draw/paint a picture in the style of one of these painters. 	<p align="center"><u>Literacy</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Write a lesson plan for your class on a lesson of your choice. Remember to include what you'll say and do and the independent work. Design a new book cover for the book you are currently reading. Write a blurb to persuade readers to read one of your favourite books. 	<p align="center"><u>Citizenship</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Research local volunteering opportunities in your community eg litter picking, fundraising for a charity. Ask your family members if they are blood donors, find out one fact about blood donation. What do you think it means to be a 'good global citizen'? Design a poster or leaflet.
<p align="center"><u>Topic</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Write a story, letter or a diary entry related to your new topic. Research and draw a timeline for the period of history you are studying. Find out about a famous person about the period of time you are studying. How were they significant? What did he/she do? What was their impact? 	<p align="center"><u>Me</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Learn a new game or skill s perhaps a card game, how to tie your laces or perform a particular dance move. Write your CV. Imagine you are applying for a job; what skills and attributes do you have that an employer would be impressed by? Write a letter to a new child in reception describing how you have changed in primary school. 	<p align="center"><u>Science</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Design a crazy invention. Use labels to explain the parts. You could get inspiration from the 'Cracking Contraptions' videos on YouTube. Plant a fruit or vegetable seed and nurture it through to it producing its fruit/veg. Design and construct something that will protect an egg from cracking if dropped.
