#### **Bad Weather Arrangements**

With weather warnings being issued for other parts of the country, this seems an appropriate time to remind parents about our procedures for bad weather. If there should be a snowfall during term time it may be necessary to close the school if we are unable to provide a safe environment for the children. This includes not having sufficient staff on site to provide an adequate level of supervision. In the event that the decision is made to close the school, parents will be notified in three ways.

- **Internet**: <u>www.hertsdirect.org</u> will contain information about the closure status of all schools in Hertfordshire. This can also be accessed from the front page of the Windermere website.
- Text: We will send a text to all parents for whom we have up to date mobile phone numbers.
  If you have recently changed your telephone number, then you should check that the office has your current mobile number listed.
- Radio: Three Counties Radio will include information about school closures during their broadcasts.

If the weather changes during the course of the school day, we are sometimes obliged to close early to ensure that everyone – children and staff – can get home safely. If this looks possible, then please look out for notification of an early closure on your mobile phones.

I hope that you all have a safe and enjoyable Christmas holiday. Please remember that we close at 2pm on Friday 19<sup>th</sup> December and re-open to children on Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> January 2015!
