Dear Parents and Carers,

Well done to our Year 6 pupils who worked so hard before half term in their statutory assessment tests (SATs). The test papers were sealed immediately after completion and collected by courier, so we must now patiently await the results in July. Year 2 have been completing their own assessments this term and Year 1 will soon be participating in the phonics screening check. Amidst all this testing the children are now beginning to learn songs and dances in preparation for our end of term extravaganza, Aladdin Trouble. #### **Breakfast Club**

I know that our Breakfast Club is very popular with many parents, but unfortunately we need to increase the cost from September 2015. The cost for each session will go up to £3 with a discounted rate of £1.50 for pupils who qualify for pupil premium. I am sure that you will feel this still represents good value for money.

#### Clubs – before and after school

Breakfast club starts <u>at 8 am</u> and although staff are here setting up before that time, they can not be responsible for children who are dropped off early. I am concerned that a very small number of parents think that it is acceptable to 'drop and run' before 8 am. Similarly school finishes <u>at 3:15 pm</u> and after school clubs finish <u>at 4.30 pm</u> (with the exception of Cook club which finishes at 5pm). An increasing number of parents are collecting their children late and too often without a word of apology. This is not acceptable and if it continues we will have to look at charging parents for the inconvenience as for safeguarding reasons we have to pay *two* members of staff to wait until the last child is collected.

After some clearing up showers today we are looking forward to a lovely day for our summer fair tomorrow. Thank you if you have volunteered to help out on the day or beforehand setting up. If you aren't able to do either of those please make sure that you bring friends and family along to share in the fun.
