O2 - Young Voices

Welcome back to a new term. We seem to have only been back five minutes and already our choir have been off to the O2 Arena for the Young Voices concert. Mrs Baskerville has been rehearsing with the children for several months and her enthusiasm and hard work were rewarded not just by the beautiful singing and the sense of enjoyment, but also by the exemplary behaviour shown by our pupils. *Obviously* we expect nothing less, but it is always a delight when we receive compliments on our children's behaviour.

Winter Weather
