- To use an iPad or computer and write a summary of your favourite book or TV programme
- Create an alphabet code (A=1, B=2) and work out the value of each spelling word.
  Which word has the highest score?
- Find a poem to learn and recite off by heart.

## Citizenship

- Create a poster to show your dreams and goals for the future
- Read a local newspaper article and discuss it with your family
- Do a litter pick in your local area

#### Topic

- Design your own branching database for at least 4 animals
- Create a poster to show what you have been learning in your chosen subject
- To send an email (using your school email address) to a friend asking them what their favourite subject at school is. If you receive an email, make sure you reply!

#### Me

- Draw pictures of what you think you may be doing at age 16, 26 and 55 and include a timeline.
- Call a family member and have a phone conversation about what you did that day at school.
- To think of the job you would like to have when you are older and draw a business card.
