Dear Parents and Carers of Year 6,

Happy New Year! We all hope that you have all had a lovely Christmas break. Over the Spring term your children are going to be studying these topics and taking part in lots of exciting learning opportunities including the Mini Police program with Hertfordshire Constabulary.

**English:** We will be exploring a range of texts in fiction, non-fiction, poetry, as well as writing nonchronological reports and persuasive letters. These will include Night of the Gargoyles, The Piano, Hermelin recounts and Cogheart.

Maths: Children will be working on decimals, up to 2 decimal places, percentages, algebra, ratio as well as area and perimeter.

History: We will be learning about the second World War and how it shaped the UK today.

Geography: Learning about natural resources, locations, trade and sustainability.

**Science:** Children will be learning about how the body and vital organs work, as well as maintaining a healthy immune and digestive system.

Art: Brave Colour. Exploring how artists use light and colour in their work.

**Computing:** Creating media and data and information spreadsheets.

French: World War II and weekend activities.

All of their homework will be set through google classroom, which the children will be able to complete and send through this. Spellings will be set every Monday to be used in a dictation on Friday with the expectation of them being learnt and practised to give them the best chance of doing well and to be able to apply in their writing. We do expect the children to read daily. This should then be logged into their reading records and checked.

Our PE sessions this term will be on Mondays and Wednesdays. Please ensure children have their PE kits in school. Please also ensure they have a water bottle each day and that everything is named.
